## Program Specific

### Arts:

Elizabeth Morrison Barron Memorial Art Scholarship: Second year art student. Most deserving who has demonstrated talent and love of Art. Selection based on merit and/or financial need. Art Faculty Selection.

The Mary Evans Calhoon Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is designed for a second year art student who plans to continue the study of art at a senior institution. The recipient must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better to retain the scholarship.

The Jeanne Hastings Art Scholarship The Hastings Scholarship, named for a former art professor at the college, is awarded to a talented rising second year art student who has financial need and plans to enter a career in art.

### Associate Degree Nursing:

Ruth D. Barrett Memorial Scholarship First-year student accepted into ADN program. The student must have/maintain 3.0 GPA. Must demonstrate financial need and have participated as a volunteer in community service.

The Ruth Earle Betts Endowed Nursing Scholarship Second Year nursing student that shows promise. The recipient must exhibit financial need.

C. Franklin & Helene K. Bracken Scholarship First or Second year student with full acceptance in ADN or Health Science Program. Must have and maintain 2.25 GPA. Must be passing co-requisites in curriculum (i.e., Anatomy & Physiology, English, Clinicals, etc. Need two recommendations from instructors (at least one from a speciality course). Must complete FASFA.

William J. and Thora Burke Endowed Scholarship Full acceptance in ADN, Health Science or Accounting. Must maintain 2.25 GPA and demonstrate financial need. May continue second year if qualified.

Dr. Clay Daughtridge Nursing Scholarship Second year nursing student believed to have potential for success. Demonstrated financial need. Demonstrated above and beyond acts of kindness.

Betty Gardner Nursing Scholarship First year ADN student who is judged to have outstanding potential and need of financial assistance. May continue second year.

The Carol & Ruth Januzik Endowed Nursing Scholarship First year ADN student with demonstrated potential for success and merit. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA. May continue second year.

The Charles F. Jones Endowed Nursing Scholarship First or second-year ADN student. Must be a Moore County resident and have financial need. May continue second year, if qualified.

The Florence Lyons Rogers Trust Scholarship First year ADN student judged to have outstanding potential for success. Request that the recipient agree to work within 60 miles of SCC for at least three years. Recipient must perform community service at least one hour per month while receiving scholarship. Must maintain a GPA of 3.0. Follow-up required with the donor for five years after graduation.

The Ellis Nursing Education Scholarship Second year nursing student with financial need who is academically qualified to complete the ADN program. Preference is given to a student who plans to work at FirstHealth Moore Hospital following graduation.

The Catherine Norman McKeithen Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year student with financial need who has shown potential for success and demonstrated good character.

The Robert E. Moore & Ann Rush Nursing Scholarship Awarded to a promising second year nursing student. The recipient must exhibit financial need.

The Penick Village Nursing Scholarship Second year nursing student with leadership potential. Preference is given to student with an interest in geriatrics.

The Pinehurst Medical Clinic Gastroenterology Scholarship Awarded to a second year ADN student who has demonstrated outstanding clinical performance during his/her first year. Requires that the recipient has and maintain a 2.0 GPA.

The Pinehurst Medical Clinic Nursing Scholarship This scholarship is designed for a second year ADN student who demonstrates potential, has enthusiasm, shows care and concern for patients, and has financial need.

Louise and Horace Porter Endowed Nursing Scholarship First year ADN or LPN student based on merit, from Moore or Lee County. Not eligible for Pell but show need. Prefer re-entry students or current CNA's who wish to advance.

St. Joseph of the Pines ADN Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to second year nursing student. The recipient must maintain a passing grade and provide satisfactory references. Preference given to St. Joseph's employees or their dependents with interest in, but not limited to, geriatric care. Should demonstrate financial need.

The Village Chapel ADN Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to four second year ADN students who have financial need and show potential for success.

## **Practical Nursing**

The Village Chapel LPN Scholarship Two first year scholarships available for LPN students. Must show financial need. Must demonstrate academic potential for success as an LPN.

## **Health Science Program**

### **Medical Lab Technology**

The C. Harold Steffee Memorial Scholarship The Steffee Scholarship is awarded to a rising second year student in the Medical Laboratory Technology program who demonstrates potential in clinical and classroom work.

### **Radiology**

The Pollyanna Cobb Phillips Scholarship First or second year radiography student with financial need. Must show financial need and academic promise to complete the Radiography program. May receive for second year if qualified.

### **Respiratory Technology**

The Miriam J. Burlingame Endowed Scholarship Second year respiratory student with potential for success in the study of respiratory care. Demonstrated financial need.

The Edgar W. Meyers Scholarship Program Awarded to two first or second year Respiratory students who reside in Lee County, although residents of other counties are considered. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or better and financial need.

The Winfred Isom Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first or second year student in Respiratory Technology who is academically sound, demonstrates financial need, and is highly motivated.

### **Surgical Technology**

Pinehurst Surgical Clinic Michael T. Pishko Scholarship This scholarship goes to a first year student who exhibits financial need and ability. (Fall semester application and selection.)

### **Therapeutic Massage**

Massage Therapy Scholarship Full-time second year student enrolled in Massage Therapy Technology. Potential for success and financial need.

### **Any Medical Program**

The Pinehurst Surgical Clinic Nursing & Health Science Scholarship Sixteen scholarships are awarded to first or second year ADN or Allied Health students (not Surgical Technology) with potential for success. Must demonstrate excellent patient care during the first year of clinicals and have financial need. Scholarships are available to graduates of Moore County high schools and specific other high schools in surrounding counties

Benevolent Patriotic Order of Does First or second year female student enrolled in any medical program. Must show financial need and be a Moore County resident.

## **Automotive**

George B. Little Automotive Service Technology Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first year Automotive Service Technology student who is a Moore county resident and shows financial need.

## **Business:**

The Harold M. Cole Scholarship Awarded to two rising second year students in accounting. Applicants should have financial need.

William E. and Margaret Covington Scholarship First or second-year Business or Accounting student. Must maintain 2.0 GPA. Student should demonstrate financial need.

The Betty K. Ray Memorial Scholarship First year student who demonstrates need for financial assistance to continue pursuit of career in business. May be awarded second year if 3.0 GPA is maintained.

The First Bank Scholarship Awarded to a rising second year student in accounting or business administration who demonstrates potential for success and exhibits financial need.

Gene and Katie Watts Business Scholarship Rising second year business major. Student must have shown potential for success in business career based on first year's performance.

The James & Nancy Kaeser Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year business student majoring in accounting, business administration, or a business transfer program. The recipient must hold a 2.5 GPA from his or her first year of study at Sandhills. Must demonstrate a degree of maturity and experience.

Moore County Leadership Institute Business Scholarship First year Moore County High School graduate seeking business major. Recipient plans to transfer to a four-year college. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate prior/potential leadership skills.

The J.C. & Jean Robbins Endowed Business Scholarship Second year business student. Business transfer preferred to continue at a four-year college or university. If none available, select Technical Business student. Outstanding personality, good character, and exhibits solid citizenship.

The Garman Endowed Scholarship First year student majoring in business, medical, science or fine arts. Student should have and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA. May continue second year.

## **Turf Grass Management**

The Donnell G. (Buck) Adams Memorial Endowed Scholarship Second Year student in Turfgrass Management program. Preference given to students from the Carolinas. Must maintain 2.5 GPA. Should demonstrate financial need and potential for success.

Don Padgett Endowed Scholarship for Golf Course/Turf Grass Management First year student accepted into the program. Preference given to employees or family members of Pinehurst Resorts. Should maintain a 2.5 GPA. May continue second year if qualified.

Sandhills Hospitality Association Scholarship-Turfgrass Program Second year student enrolled in Turf Grass Management. Must maintain 2.0 GPA to receive scholarship for subsequent semesters.

## **Cosmetology**

Lucille McSwain Memorial Cosmetology Scholarship First year student enrolling in Cosmetology. Single parent preferred. Potential for success and maintain 3.0 GPA.

## **Criminal Justice**

Mike McBride Criminal Justice Scholarship Full-time student enrolled in Criminal Justice Program. Potential and desire for success. Financial need considered. Should maintain 2.5 GPA.

## **Engineering**

The Riden Tyler Bennett & Ruth Cashwell Bennett Scholarship Awarded to a second year student in Civil Engineering Technology who demonstrates financial need.

C.H. "Pat" Blue Memorial Surveying Scholarship First or second year student enrolled in Surveying Technology with financial need. Potential for success. Must maintain 3.0 GPA.

The Reynold S. Davenport Scholarship First year student enrolled in Civil Engineering or Surveying Technology. Recommendations for applicants should reflect the student's potential for success.

Gary F. Spitler Land Surveying Scholarship First year student in Surveying Technology. Recommendations should reflect the student's potential for success.

The T. T. Hayes Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a rising second year Architectural Technology student who has exhibited satisfactory progress in the first year of the program and is in financial need.

The Stephen N. Martin, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a second-year student in Architectural or Civil Engineering Technology who has demonstrated a potential for success in the first year of studies and who has financial need.

The Wellard Scholarship Fund Preference to student seeking two-year Engineering or Computer Technology degree or college transfer program. Demonstrated dedication and potential for success. Must maintain 3.0 GPA. May receive second year.

## **GED Graduate**

The Rachel H. Stone GED Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first year student who has successfully completed the GED test at Sandhills Community College, and demonstrated potential for academic success. Rachel H. Stone served as a committed GED instructor from 1968 until 1989. The student must demonstrate financial need and a history of overcoming hardship.

The C. Harlan McCaskill Scholarship This scholarship, named for the college's first dean of continuing education, goes to a second year SCC GED graduate of the college who has successfully completed his/her first year of study and demonstrates financial need.

## **Human Services Technology**

The Miriam Chesham Borel Endowed Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year Human Services Technology student in financial need who has demonstrated potential in the HST program.

## **Information Systems**

The Ollie & Wanda Sweeney Management & Information Systems Scholarship Awarded to a second year Information Systems student. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of merit (75%) and need (25%). The recipient must maintain a 3.0 GPA and exhibit dedication and potential for success in business.

## **Hotel & Restaurant Management & Culinary**

Michael Douglas Edwards Scholarship for Culinary Arts Second year Culinary Arts student. Exhibit strong potential for success and desire to complete program. Exemplified giving of oneself and leadership qualities in school activities and community. Student should have/maintain 3.25 GPA.

George Bampton Little Memorial Scholarship First or second year Culinary Arts student. Preference given to Pickney Academy attendees. Recommendations should express potential for success in Culinary Arts. May have demonstrated financial need.

Jean Cosgrove Stevenson Memorial Scholarship First year Hotel and Restaurant Management student. Associates from Mid Pines/Pine Needles preferred. May receive second year if qualified. Selected by SCC Scholarship Committee and Mid Pines Scholarship Committee.

The Stephen E. Schutt Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year student enrolled in the Hotel & Restaurant program who demonstrates financial need.

Jean Cosgrove Stevenson Memorial Scholarship First year Hotel and Restaurant Management student. Associates from Mid Pines/Pine Needles preferred. May receive second year if qualified. Selected by Scholarship Committee and Mid Pines Scholarship Committee.

## **College Transfer Programs**

The Richard and Silvia Bisbe Endowed Scholarship First or second year student enrolled in college transfer program, working towards an Associate in Science. Maintain a 3.0 GPA and demonstrated potential for success.

The Boelsen-Baird Endowed Scholarship Awarded to a second year student enrolled in a college transfer program, preferably in English or Psychology, who intends to major in the liberal arts or sciences. The recipient must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA.

The Blanchie D. Carter Scholarship First year student who must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA with plans to pursue a career in education. (Preference given to those who attended Southern Pines Elementary School.)

The Nathaniel P. Carter Scholarship First year applicant to Sandhills who must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA with plans to pursue a career in education. (Preference given to those who attended Aberdeen Middle School).

Eleanor Coppedge Memorial Scholarship Awarded to female student enrolled in Science or Education. Financial need and maintain 3.0 GPA.

The Wray Thompson Thorn Honor Scholarship This scholarship is designed for a College Transfer honor student planning to major in history. The recipient must be a second year student who demonstrates some financial need and maintains a 3.5 GPA.

The Bill Jones Scholarship First year student enrolled in Journalism/English major and seeking a career in journalism. Student must plan to continue his/her studies in journalism at a four-year institution. May continue second year if qualified.

The Ollie and Wanda Sweeney Education Scholarship Awarded to second year student who plans to pursue degree in education at UNC-Greensboro. Based on 75% merit and 25% need. Demonstrate dedication and potential for success. Must maintain 3.0 GPA. May continue scholarship at UNC-Greensboro with full-time enrollment and verification of enrollment.

The Furches Scholars Program First year student enrolled in the College Transfer program. The applicant must maintain a 3.0 GPA and be planning to transfer to UNC/Chapel Hill upon graduation from Sandhills. May continue for second year. Student may continue to receive funds at UNC-Chapel Hill with verification of full-time enrollment and maintaining 3.0 GPA.

Women of the Pines Scholarship First or second year student, College Transfer or Associate, enrolled in teaching, nursing, or social services curriculum. Must have financial need and demonstrate academic potential for success in one of these fields.

The American Association of University Women Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year female student in any college transfer program in need of financial support. The recipient's first year GPA must be 2.5 or higher.

The Francis F. Rainey Education Foundation Scholarship First or second year Moore County resident.. One male and one female. Preference given to students who plans to pursue a career of service to state or nation. May continue at four-year institution with verification of full-time enrollment and satisfactory GPA.

## **Landscape Gardening**

The Cornelia L. Blue Memorial Landscape Gardening Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a rising second year Landscape Gardening student who demonstrates a potential for success in this field.

The N.C. Unit of the Herb Society of America Scholarship First Year Landscape Gardening student. Must maintain a 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to a student whose goal is to work in a public garden.

The Garden Club of CCNC Horticulture Scholarship First or second year student in Landscape Gardening program. The applicant will be selected based on merit and need.

The Grace Sullivan Memorial Horticulture Scholarship First year full-time Landscape Gardening student with financial need and academic ability. A Greensboro or Guilford County native is preferred. (Fall semester application and selection.) Two year scholarship.

The Southern Pines Garden Club Scholarship One first year and one second year Landscape Gardening student with financial need. Prefer a North Carolina resident with emphasis based on academic promise. May continue for the second year if qualified.

The Steed Scholarship First or second year in-state student enrolled full-time. Financial need demonstrated. Willingness to use his or her ability for success.

The Willene & William P. Davis Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first or second year student enrolled in the Landscape Gardening program. Satisfactory progress during the first year will determine the continuation of the scholarship the second year.

The Garden Club of the Sandhills Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student with a GPA of 2.3 or better. The applicant must be a North Carolina resident who has financial need.

The Garner Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student who is a Moore County high school graduate, shows potential for success in the study of landscape gardening, and has financial need.

The David L. Knight Landscape Gardening Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student with a GPA of 2.5 or better. The recipient should demonstrate the ability to apply academic training in a practical setting. Preference is given to North Carolina residents with financial need.

The Joseph Van Auken Longcor Endowed Scholarship Preference to first or second year student accepted into Landscape Gardening or ADN. Must demonstrate financial need and maintain 3.0 GPA. North Carolina resident preferred. If out of state, must show financial need. Potential for success. If no LSG or ADN students eligible, select from other programs.

The Duncan C. & Sarah Jane McGill Scholarship Awarded to nine Landscape Gardening students for taking the Certified Plantsman Exam. The recipient must demonstrate academic promise.

Bruce and Helen Miller Endowed Scholarship First or second year Landscape Gardening student. Potential for success and dedicated to LSG field. Maintain a 2.5 GPA.

The Pinehurst Garden Club Horticultural Scholarship This scholarship will be awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student who has demonstrated potential in first year.

## **Music**

The Cornelia Morrison Bentley Endowed Classical Music Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year classical music major who demonstrates a strong aptitude for or talent in vocal or instrumental music with a possible goal of performing.

The Moore County Choral Society Endowed Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year vocal or choral music major with a 3.0 GPA. Recipients will be selected by the SCC music faculty.

The Mary Abraham Hodgkins Endowed Music Scholarship This scholarship is designated for a second year music major with either keyboard, band, or orchestra instrument as a performing medium. An audition is required.

Academic promise, financial need and potential for success. Preference given to first generation college students. The number to be awarded each year reviewed by the college.

Richard S. Waterman Scholarship in honor of The American Red Cross Five first or second year in-state students enrolled full-time in any program. Scholarships awarded based on merit and financial need.

The Belk Scholars at Sandhills First or second-year student enrolled full-time in any program. Selection based on merit and financial need.

Emily S. Bowles Endowed Scholarship First year student in any program with financial need. Student may receive second year if qualified.

Brownson Presbyterian Church Scholarship Fund First or second year student. Recipient must be a current member of Brownson Memorial Presbyterian Church of Southern Pines and a member for at least 2 yrs. Must have and maintain a "C" average on high school and college.

The Capel Scholars Program First year students. Majoring in any program, preference to business or healthcare. Must maintain 2.5 GPA. Selection based on merit and need. May continue second year.

Cato-J. T. Cotner Endowed Scholarship Must be resident where Cato has a market presence. Financial need. Preference to students with evidence of work and community service history.

Central Electric Scholarship First year student in any program. Must be a member of CEMC or child of a member and reside in member home. Based on academics & community activity. May continue second year.

Dr. James E. Cook Endowed Scholarship Any first year student enrolled in any program. Must maintain 2.0 GPA. Potential for success. Leadership shown in high school.

Irene and Lowell Corbin Scholarship A first or second year student enrolled in any program. Should demonstrate merit and financial need. Must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Fritz and Olga Fuerst Scholarship First or second year student who is needy and/or deserving and enrolled full-time.

John Krepick Memorial Endowed Scholarship Full-time student enrolled in any program but preference given to Business majors. Student demonstrate integrity and initiative. Must provide evidence of community service, especially with youth and team sports. Plans to work in the summer. High School GPA of 3.0 required.

Frank L. and Gladys C. Guydes Scholarship Two students enrolled in any program. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA. May continue second year if qualified.

Crystal Dawn Harrelson Memorial Scholarship First year graduate of Hoke High School. Shown exemplified giving of oneself and leadership in school activities and community. May continue second year if qualified.

Travis Hill Memorial Scholarship First year graduate of North Moore High School. Should maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Hoke High Class of 1954 Scholarship First or second year student enrolled full-time who is a resident of Hoke County. Student must have financial need.

Dr. Julian Lake and Family Scholarship Any first year student enrolled in any program. Must maintain a 2.0 GPA. Recommendations should express student's potential for success.

Luke Marion Scholarship First year student. Graduate of Union Pines High School. Demonstrated potential for success. Financial need should be a consideration. Recommendation and selection from Counselors at Union Pines High School.

Woodrow and Mary McInnis Scholarship First year student enrolled in any program. Must be a resident of Richmond County (Mineral Springs Township I or II-Ellerbe, Norman, Wind Blow or Derby. Should demonstrate financial need.

McNeill-Woodward Endowed Scholarship Two students who are residents of Hoke County. Must have financial need. May continue second year if qualified.

The David & Carolyn Murphy Scholarship The recipient of this scholarship will be a second year student enrolled in any SCC curriculum program who maintains a 3.0 GPA. Selection is based on merit and financial need. Residents of Moore and Montgomery Counties are preferred.

Marge Owings/Keep Moore County Beautiful Scholarship First year Moore County graduate. Must have been involved in volunteer activities and leadership roles. May continue second year with 3.0 GPA.

The Rainmakers Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year student enrolled in any program. The recipient must be a single parent who has overcome barriers.

Rotary Club of the Sandhills Book Scholarship Second year student enrolled in a technical program. Must be resident of Moore County and have/maintain a 3.0 GPA.

William F. Ruska Scholarship Second year student judged to have potential for success. Must maintain 2.0 GPA and demonstrate need. Any program.

Sandhills Community College Scholars Students graduating in the top 15% of high schools to include Pinecrest, Union Pines, North Moore and Hoke High. Must have/maintain a 3.5 GPA.

The SCC Student Government Association Scholarship This scholarship is open to two students and is awarded based on GPA. Selection is determined by the applicant's academic improvement in their first year of study and their involvement in the welfare of the college.

General A.G. Schwenk Book Fund Selection will be made of honorably discharged, male and female personnel enrolled in a degree program. 1<sup>st</sup>) Marines and Navy Medical Corpsman having served with the Fleet Marine Force in excess of 90 days; 2<sup>nd</sup>) Children of deceased Marines or US Navy Corpsmen; 3<sup>rd</sup>) US Navy personnel; and 4<sup>th</sup>) Other US military services and US Coast Guard.

SECU Foundation Scholarship Four students in any program with preference to employees/family members in public sector jobs (all federal, state, local gov. agencies). NC resident/graduate of NC high school with financial need. Must maintain a 2.5 GPA. Final approval NC Community College System.

William Halley Smith and Edith Thomas Scholarship Three first year students enrolled in any program. Must be a graduate in the upper 20% of a Moore County school (public or private). Must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Jean and Mary Jane Souweine Scholarship First year student in any program. Student should have demonstrated potential for success in high school and financial need. May continue second year if overall 2.5 GPA maintained.

Embarq Telephone Scholarship Second year student enrolled in any technical or vocational program. Priority given to students hit by recession or displaced workers seeking new job skills.

Robert and Dorothy Swift Scholarship First or second year student. Selection based on merit, need and potential for success. May receive second year if qualified.

A.A. Vanore Endowed Scholarship Graduate of North Moore High School. Highest ranking graduate in the top one-third of class enrolled in Nursing, Health Science or Pre-Med. Selection made by North Moore High School and SCC Committee.

Robert and Temperence Zimmerman Scholarship First or second year student selected based on need and merit. Student must maintain 2.0 GPA. May continue second year if qualified.
