EMT-Paramedic

\$70 (Emergency service personnel is fee exempt)

This is a certificate paramedic class that will meet 2 or 3 nights a week on alternating months (M, W, Th, one month and M-W the next). Pre-requisites: NC EMT-Basic, Anatomy and Physiology for EMS, and must place into MAT 070 and ENG 111. Class will meet DOT standards for EMT-Paramedic curriculum and prepare students for entry level as a paramedic. Upon successful completion students will be eligible to take the NC EMT-paramedic certification exam. Text required. All interested students need to contact Tom Ferrell to register and to schedule placement tests. Placement test should be completed prior to September 1 and registration for Anatomy and Physiology. Students having prior placement scores or completed course work should submit documentation to Tom Ferrell (ferrellt@sandhills.edu or 910-695-3768).
