Elizabeth Morrison Barron Memorial Art Scholarship: A deserving second year art student who has a demonstrated talent and love of Art. Selection based on merit and/or financial need. Art Faculty Selection.

The Mary Evans Calhoon Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is designed for a second year art student who plans to continue the study of art at a senior institution. The recipient must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better to retain the scholarship.

Associate Degree Nursing

C. Franklin & Helene K. Bracken Scholarship First or Second year student with full acceptance in ADN or Health Science Program. Must have and maintain 2.25 GPA. The student must be passing co-requisites in curriculum (i.e., Anatomy & Physiology, English, Clinicals, etc. Need two recommendations from instructors (at least one from a speciality course). Need based.

The Charles F. Jones Endowed Nursing Scholarship First or second-year ADN student. Must be a Moore County resident and have financial need. The scholarship may continue a second year, if the student qualifies

The Carol & Ruth Januzik Endowed Nursing Scholarship A first year ADN student with demonstrated potential for success and merit. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA. The scholarship may continue the second year if the student qualifies.

William J. and Thora Burke Endowed Scholarship Full acceptance in ADN, Health Science or Accounting must maintain 2.25 GPA and demonstrate financial need. May continue second year if qualified.

The Gurney & Olive McLaughlin Nursing Scholarship First year ADN student enrolled fulltime, with financial need. High School graduate with recommendation that reflects high school citizenship record. The student must maintain a GPA of 2.5. May continue second year if qualified.

The Penick Village Nursing Scholarship A second year nursing student with leadership potential, preference is given to student with an interest in geriatrics.

The Bargain Box Nursing Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to an ADN or Practical Nursing student who have financial need and show potential for success.

The Ellis Nursing Education Scholarship Second year nursing student with financial need who qualified academically to complete the ADN program. Preference is given to a student who plans to work at First Health Moore Hospital following graduation.

Louise and Horace Porter Endowed Nursing Scholarship A resident of Moore or Lee county who is a first year ADN or LPN student, who has demonstrated financial need and merit. *Not eligible for Pell.* Prefer re-entry students or current CNA's who wish to advance.

The Catherine Norman McKeithen Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year student with financial need who has shown potential for success and demonstrated good character.

Betty Gardner Nursing Scholarship First year ADN student who is judged to have outstanding potential and has financial need. Scholarship may continue second year.

Sandhills Emergency Physicians Nursing Scholarship Awarded to (2) ADN students believed to have potential for success. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA. Student should demonstrate financial need and demonstrate above and beyond acts of kindness.

The Pinehurst Medical Clinic Gastroenterology Scholarship Awarded to a second year ADN student who has demonstrated outstanding clinical performance during his/her first year. Requires that the recipient has and maintain a 2.0 GPA.

Dr. Clay Daughtridge Nursing Scholarship Second year nursing student believed to have potential for success. Student should demonstrate financial need and demonstrate above and beyond acts of kindness.

Ruth D. Barrett Memorial Scholarship First-year student accepted into ADN program. The student must have/maintain 3.0 GPA. Must demonstrate financial need and have participated as a volunteer in community service.

The Pinehurst Medical Clinic Nursing Scholarship This scholarship is designed for a student who is a second year ADN major, who demonstrates potential, has enthusiasm, shows care and concern for patients, and has financial need.

Pinehurst Surgical Founders Award Scholarship Program Awarded to a first or second year Nursing or Health Science major with demonstrated financial need, judged to have outstanding potential for success. Student must have demonstrated care and concern during clinical training.

The Robert E. Moore & Ann Rush Nursing Scholarship Awarded to a promising second year nursing student. The recipient must exhibit financial need.

The Ruth Earle Betts Endowed Nursing Scholarship Second Year nursing student that shows promise. The recipient must maintain a 2.0 GPA.

The Ann Albert Memorial Nursing Scholarship Awarded to a second year ADN student believed to have potential for success. Moore County resident preferred that demonstrates financial need.

Dr. and Mrs. G. Patrick Henderson Scholarship A first or second year Nursing/Health Science student judged to have an outstanding potential for success. Student demonstrates care and concern during clinical training. Recipient must have financial need.

Matilda Grinevich Endowed Nursing Scholarship A deserving Nursing student enrolled full time in the Associate Degree Nursing Program. For fall semester to be used for books, tuition, supplies, clinical expenses, licensing exam fees, or uniforms.

The Helen Millar Associate Degree Nursing Book Fund These funds given upon recommendation from the Chair of the AD-N Program to the Financial Aid Office. Selection will be based on need for assistance.

DAR (Alston Chapter) Nursing Scholarship This scholarship is for a second year Associate Degree Nursing student and is to cover the following expenses: \$300 for books, \$300 for the Application for the State Board Exam for Licensure and \$250 for the NCLEX Review.

The Bruce Porter Nursing Scholarships This scholarship is for two first or second year nursing students with a potential for success. The students have demonstrated care and concern for patients during clinical training and have an enthusiasm for nursing. The student has financial need.

The Elma Ziegler Memorial Endowed Nursing Scholarship A first or second year Associate Degree Nursing student believed to have a potential for success and dedication to a nursing career. The student has demonstrated financial need and demonstrates acts of kindness above and beyond.

The Bradford Alden Evans Memorial Nursing Scholarship This scholarship is for a Associate Degree Nursing or Practical Nursing student who has demonstrated potential for success and has financial need.

Certified Nursing Assistant

Whispers Certified Nursing Assistant Scholarship Fund A student enrolled in the Certified Nursing Assistant Program. This student must exhibit high integrity, character, and compassion for those in need.

Sandhills Emergency Physicians EMS Scholarships Two students enrolled in EMS believed to have a potential for success. The students must maintain a 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need. The recipients should demonstrate above and beyond act of kindness.

St. Joseph of the Pines, Inc. in honor of Sr. Mary Zeno McGuirk, S.P. Awarded to a first year Licensed Practical Nursing student with financial need. Preference will be given to employees of St. Joseph of the Pines. This student must exhibit high integrity and compassion for those in need.

St. Joseph of the Pines, Inc. in honor of Sr. Constance O'Brien, S.P. Awarded to a first year Licensed Practical Nursing student with financial need. Preference will be given to employees of St. Joseph of the Pines. This student must exhibit high integrity and compassion for those in need.

The Jerry Avant Memorial Nursing Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to an Associate Degree Nursing Student or a Practical Nursing student who has demonstrated a potential for success. The student plans a career in nursing and has a strong commitment to helping others, and has demonstrated financial need.

Medical Lab Technology

The C. Harold Steffee Memorial Scholarship The Steffee Scholarship is awarded to a rising second year student in the Medical Laboratory Technology program who demonstrates potential in clinical and classroom work.

Radiology

The Pollyanna Cobb Phillips Scholarship First or second year radiography student with financial need. Student must maintain 2.0 GPA. The student must show financial need and academic promise to complete the Radiography program.

Respiratory Technology

The Winfred Isom Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first or second year student in Respiratory Technology who is academically sound, demonstrates financial need, and is highly motivated.

The Edgar W. Meyers Scholarship Program Awarded to first or second year Respiratory students who reside in Lee County, although residents of other counties are considered. Must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better and demonstrate financial need.

The Miriam J. Burlingame Endowed Scholarship First year respiratory student with potential for success in the study of respiratory care. The student must demonstrate financial need.

Surgical Technology

Pinehurst Surgical Clinic Michael T. Pishko Scholarship This scholarship goes to a first year student who exhibits financial need and ability. (Fall semester application and spring selection.)

Therapeutic Massage

Massage Therapy Scholarship Full-time second year student enrolled in Massage Therapy Technology. Student must demonstrate potential for success and financial need.

Health Science Program - General Health Science Diploma or Degree

The Arnold Family Health Science Scholarship Awarded to first year student enrolled full-time in a Health Science diploma or degree program. Must have a GPA of 3.0 and demonstrate financial aid need. Prefer a male or female single parent, but not required; if qualified will receive second year.

The Florence Lyons Rogers Trust Scholarship First year students in any medical program judged to have outstanding potential for success. Recipient must reside in **Cumberland County** and agree to work within 60 miles of SCC for at least three years. The recipient must perform community service. The student must maintain a GPA of 3.0. Student should meet complete follow-up with the Trust for five years. Recipients should arrange to meet with Mrs. Stancil at the Florence Rogers Charitable Trust Office.

The Pinehurst Surgical Clinic Nursing & Health Science Scholarship Sixteen scholarships are awarded to first or second year ADN or Health Science students (not Surgical Technology) with potential for success. Must demonstrate excellent patient care during the first year of clinical classes and have financial need. Scholarships are available to graduates of Moore County high schools and specific other high schools in surrounding counties.

A.A. Vanore Endowed Scholarship A First year student, a graduate of North Moore High School, highest ranking graduate in the top one-third of class enrolled in Nursing, Health Science or Pre-Med. Selection made by North Moore High School and SCC Committee.

Mark and Anne Lewis Endowed Fund for Student Scholars Preference to students who have taken health career courses in Moore County High Schools. Student should demonstrate financial need. Recommendations should express student's potential for success: dedication to the health care profession; and show that candidate has overcome obstacles to achieve goals. The student may continue second year if qualified. (Other degree program students may be selected if no suitable Health Science or AD-N students apply)

Automotive

George B. Little Automotive Service Technology Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first year Automotive Service Technology student who is a Moore county resident and shows financial need.

Sandhills Chapter of the Antique Automobile Club of America. (AAUW) This scholarship is awarded to students who have completed their third semester in the Automotive Technology Program. Deserving student may use the scholarship to purchase tools for use in the program. Selection will be made by the Chair of the Automotive Technology Program.

North Carolina Motorsports Foundation Scholarship Two (2) North Carolina residents enrolled in a program directly related to the motorsports industry. The student has demonstrated above average performance and has demonstrated financial need.

Business

The First Bank Scholarship Awarded to a rising second year student in accounting or business administration who demonstrates potential for success and exhibits financial need.

The Betty K. Ray Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a first year student who has demonstrated financial need to continue pursuit of a career in business. May be awarded second year if 3.0 GPA is maintained.

John Krepick Memorial Endowed Scholarship Full-time student enrolled in any program but preference given to Business majors. Student should demonstrate integrity, initiative, and provide evidence of community service. High School GPA of 3.0 required.

The James & Nancy Kaeser Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year business student majoring in accounting, business administration, or a business transfer program. The recipient must hold a 2.5 GPA from his or her first year of study at SCC, and must demonstrate a degree of maturity and experience.

Gene and Katie Watts Business Scholarship Rising second year business major. Student must have shown potential for success in business career based on first year's performance.

The Harold M. Cole Scholarship Awarded to rising second year student in accounting. Applicants should have financial need.

The Russell & Barbara Garman Endowed Scholarship A first year student majoring in business, medical program, science or fine arts. Student should have and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA. This scholarship may continue the second year if the student qualifies.

William E. and Margaret Covington Scholarship A first or second-year Business or Accounting student with demonstrated financial need. The student must maintain a 2.0 GPA.

Entrepreneurship Scholarship Student should be enrolled in the Entrepreneurship Certificate Program and has demonstrated exemplary character. Student must have demonstrated excellent potential for success as an entrepreneur. Selection is made by the faculty in the Business Administration Program.

Moore County Leadership Institute Business Scholarship A first year Moore County High School graduate, who is seeking a business major. Recipient plans to transfer to a four-year college. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate prior/potential leadership skills.

College Transfer Programs

The Bill Jones Scholarship First year student enrolled in Journalism, or English major, who is seeking a career in journalism. Student must plan to continue his or her studies in journalism at a four-year institution. May continue second year if qualified.

Women of the Pines Scholarship First or second year student, College Transfer or Associate Degree Program enrolled in teaching, nursing, or social services curriculum. Must have financial need and demonstrate academic potential for success in one of these fields.

Breakthrough Scholars College Transfer Awarded to first-year students planning to continue to a 4-yr college who has demonstrated academic promise, financial need and potential for success. Preference is given to those who are the first generation in their family to enroll in college.

The Furches Scholars Program First year student enrolled in the College Transfer program. The applicant must maintain a 3.0 GPA and be planning to transfer to UNC/Chapel Hill upon graduation from SCC. Scholarship may continue for second year if student is eligible. Student may continue to receive funds at *UNC-Chapel Hill* with verification of full-time enrollment and maintaining 3.0 GPA.

Eleanor Coppedge Memorial Scholarship Awarded to female student enrolled in College Transfer Science or Education. Financial need and maintain 3.0 GPA.

The American Association of University Women Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year female student in any college transfer program in need of financial support. The recipient's first year GPA must be 2.5 or higher.

The Blanchie D. Carter Scholarship A first year student who must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA with plans to pursue a career in education, preference given to those who attended Southern Pines Elementary School.

The Nathaniel P. Carter Scholarship A first year student must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and who has plans to pursue a career in education, with preference is given to those who attended Aberdeen Middle School.

The Francis F. Rainey Education Foundation Scholarship This recipient must be a first or second year Moore County resident. One male and one female student selected. Preference is given to students who plan to pursue a career of service to state or nation. Scholarship may continue at a four-year institution with verification of full-time enrollment and satisfactory GPA.

The Ollie and Wanda Sweeney Education Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to second year student who plans to pursue degree in education at **UNC-Greensboro**. Selection is based on 75% merit and 25% need. Demonstrate dedication and potential for success. The recipient must maintain 3.0 GPA. The scholarship may continue at UNC-Greensboro with full-time enrollment and verification of enrollment.

The J.C. & Jean Robbins Endowed Business Scholarship A second year business student. Business transfer preferred to continue at a four-year college or university. If none available, select Technical Business student. Outstanding personality, good character, and exhibits solid citizenship.

The Boelsen-Baird Endowed Scholarship Awarded to a second year student enrolled in a college transfer program, preferably in English or Psychology, who intends to major in the liberal arts or sciences. The recipient must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA.

The Richard and Silvia Bisbe Endowed Scholarship A first or second year student enrolled in a college transfer program, working towards an Associate in Science. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate potential for success.

Wray Thompson Thorn Endowed Honor Scholarship This scholarship is for a College Transfer honors student planning to major in history. The recipient must be a second year student who demonstrates some financial need and maintains a 3.5 GPA.

St. Joseph of the Pines, Inc. in honor of Sr. Mary Peter Meckel, S.P. First or second year student majoring in Social Work who has demonstrated financial need. Preference will be given to employees of St. Joseph of the Pines. The student must exhibit high integrity and compassion for those in need.

Computer Technology

Breakthrough Scholars Computer Technology Scholarships First-year students enrolled in any Computer Technology Program. Student must demonstrate academic promise, financial need, and potential for success. Preference is given to first generation in their family to enroll in college.

The Ollie & Wanda Sweeney Computer Engineering Scholarship Awarded to a second year Computer Engineering student. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of merit (75%) and need (25%). The recipient must maintain a 3.0 GPA and exhibit dedication and potential for success in business.

Cosmetology

Lucille McSwain Memorial Cosmetology Scholarship A first year student enrolled in Cosmetology, a single parent preferred, who has demonstrated a potential for success. Student should maintain 3.0 GPA.

Criminal Justice

The Justin Garner Criminal Justice Scholarship The student has completed the Basic Law Enforcement Training planning to enroll in the Criminal Justice Technology program. The student should demonstrate the potential for success and plans on a career in Law Enforcement. The student should have a strong commitment to helping others and have financial need.

Culinary Arts

Brittany Racey Culinary Scholarship High School graduate enrolled in Culinary Arts. The student must have aspirations for employment in Culinary upon graduation or desire to continue education. Involvement in community and/or church activities and must maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Michael Douglas Edwards Scholarship for Culinary Arts A second year Culinary Art student who exhibits a strong potential for success and desire to complete the program. The student exemplifies giving of oneself and leadership qualities in school activities and community. Student should have and maintain a 3.25 GPA.

George Bampton Little Memorial Scholarship A first or second year Culinary Arts student. Preference given to Pickney Academy attendees and recommendations should express potential for success in Culinary Arts. The student may demonstrate financial need.

St Joseph of the Pines, Inc. in honor of Sr. Mary McGrath, S.P. A first or second year Culinary Arts student who has financial need. Preference is given to employees of St. Joseph of the Pines. This student exhibits high integrity and dedication to excellence.

Moore County Chamber of Commerce Culinary Showcase Scholarships Two scholarships awarded to students enrolled in a SCC Culinary Arts or Hospitality Program. The scholarships should be given to residents of Moore County.

Early Childhood Education

Kiwanis Club of Pinehurst First year student enrolled in Early Childhood Education. Must be enrolled full-time and maintain a 2.5 GPA. Student should demonstrate participation in volunteer activities and leadership roles.

Engineering

Breakthrough Scholars Scholarships Awarded to first-year students enrolled in any Engineering Technology Program. Students must demonstrate academic promise, financial need and a potential for success. A preference is given to first generation college students. Recipient may continue second year if qualified.

The Wellard Scholarship Fund Preference to student seeking a two-year Engineering or Computer Technology degree or college transfer program. The student must demonstrate a dedication to their program and a potential for success. The recipient must maintain 3.0 GPA and may receive a second year if eligible.

The T. T. Hayes Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a rising second year Architectural Technology student who has exhibited satisfactory progress in the first year of the program and is in financial need.

C.H. "Pat" Blue Memorial Surveying Scholarship A first or second year student enrolled in Surveying Technology with financial need and a demonstrated potential for success. The student must maintain 3.0 GPA.

The Reynold S. Davenport Scholarship First year student enrolled in Civil Engineering or Surveying Technology. Recommendations for applicants should reflect the student's potential for success.

The Ridsen & Ruth Bennett Scholarship Awarded to a second year student in Civil Engineering Technology who demonstrates financial need.

The Stephen N. Martin, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a second-year student in Architectural or Civil Engineering Technology who has demonstrated a potential for success in the first year of studies and who has financial need.

GED Graduate

The Rachel H. Stone GED Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first year student who has successfully completed the GED test at Sandhills Community College, and demonstrated potential for academic success. Rachel H. Stone served as a committed GED instructor from 1968 until 1989. The student must demonstrate financial need and a history of overcoming hardship.

Wanda Sweeney GED Endowed Scholarship Recipient must have successfully completed the GED test at Sandhills Community College. Student should have financial need and a history of overcoming hardship or barriers to attendance and potential for academic success.

The C. Harlan McCaskill Scholarship This scholarship, named for the college's first dean of continuing education, goes to a second year SCC GED graduate of the college who has successfully completed his/her first year of study and demonstrates financial need.

Hotel & Restaurant Management

Jean Cosgrove Stevenson Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is for a first year Hotel and Restaurant Management student. Associates from Mid Pines/Pine Needles preferred. The student may receive second year if qualified. Selection is made by the SCC and Mid Pines Scholarship Committees.

The Stephen E. Schutt Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year student enrolled in the Hotel & Restaurant program who demonstrates financial need.

Human Services Technology

The Miriam Chesham Borel Endowed Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year Human Services Technology student with financial need who has demonstrated potential in the HST program.

The Bessie Hedrick Memorial Human Service Technology Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in Human Services who has a strong commitment to helping others. The student also has demonstrated financial need.

Landscape Gardening

The Linden Garden Club of Pinewild (book fund) Books for a deserving Landscape Gardening student.

The Pinehurst Garden Club Horticultural Scholarship This scholarship will be awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student who has demonstrated potential in first year.

The Southern Pines Garden Club Scholarship This scholarship is available for one first year and one second year Landscape Gardening student with financial need. Prefer a North Carolina resident with emphasis based on academic promise. Scholarship may continue for the second year if the student qualifies.

The David L. Knight Landscape Gardening Memorial Scholarship Awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student with a GPA of 2.5 or better. The recipient should demonstrate the ability to apply academic training in a practical setting. Preference is given to North Carolina residents with financial need.

Bruce and Helen Miller Endowed Scholarship First or second year Landscape Gardening student with the potential for success and dedicated to LSG field. Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

The Garden Club of CCNC Horticulture Scholarship Recipient may be a first or second year student in Landscape Gardening Program. The applicant will be selected based on merit and need.

The Grace Sullivan Memorial Horticulture Scholarship The recipient should be a full-time, first year Landscape Gardening student with financial need and academic ability. A Greensboro or Guilford County native is preferred. (Fall semester application and selection.) May receive the scholarship the second year if the student is eligible

The Garden Club of the Sandhills Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student with a GPA of 2.3 or better. The applicant must be a North Carolina resident who has financial need.

The N.C. Unit of the Herb Society of America Scholarship The recipient of this scholarship must be a first year Landscape Gardening student. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to a student whose goal is to work in a public garden.

The Joseph Van Auken Longcor Endowed Scholarship Preference to first or second year student accepted into Landscape Gardening or ADN. Must demonstrate financial need and maintain 3.0 GPA. North Carolina resident preferred. If out of state, must show financial need. The student should demonstrate the potential for success. If no LSG or ADN students eligible, select from other programs.

The Cornelia Blue Memorial Scholarship A second-year Landscape Gardening student with demonstrated potential for success in program.

The Willene & William P. Davis Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a first or second year student enrolled in the Landscape Gardening program. Satisfactory progress during the first year will determine the continuation of the scholarship the second year.

The Garner Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year Landscape Gardening student who is a Moore County high school graduate, shows potential for success in the study of landscape gardening, and has financial need.

The Steed Scholarship Awarded to Landscape Gardening students to assist with the Summer Field Trip educational expenses.

The Duncan C. & Sarah Jane McGill Scholarship Awarded to nine Landscape Gardening students for taking the Certified Plantsman Exam. The recipient must demonstrate academic promise.

Music

The Cornelia Morrison Bentley Endowed Classical Music Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year classical music major who demonstrates a strong aptitude for or talent in vocal or instrumental music with a possible goal of performing.

The Moore County Choral Society Endowed Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year vocal or choral music major with a 3.0 GPA. Recipients will be selected by the SCC music faculty.

The Mary Abraham Hodgkins Endowed Music Scholarship This scholarship is for a second year music major with either keyboard, band, or orchestra instrument as a performing medium. An audition is required.

Turf Grass Management

Don Padgett Endowed Scholarship for Golf Course/Turf Grass Management First year student accepted into the program. Preference is given to employees or family members of Pinehurst Resorts. Student should maintain a 2.5 GPA. May continue second year if qualified.

The Donnell G. (Buck) Adams Memorial Endowed Scholarship Second year student in the Turfgrass Management program. Preference is given to students from the Carolinas. Student must maintain 2.5 GPA and should demonstrate financial need and potential for success.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

SECU Foundation Scholarship Four students in any program with preference to employees/family members in a public sector job (all federal, state, local government agencies). Student should be a North Carolina resident and is eligible for in-state tuition. Also, the student must be a graduate of a North Carolina High School with financial need. Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA. Final approval is made by NC Community College System.

Robert and Dorothy Swift Endowed Scholarship Four first or second year students in any major. Selection is based on merit, need and potential for success. Student's must maintain a 2.0 GPA and may receive the scholarship a second year if qualified.

Frank L. and Gladys C. Guydes Scholarship One students enrolled in any program. The student must maintain a 3.0 GPA. May continue second year if qualified.

Richard S. Waterman Scholarship in honor of The American Red Cross First or second year in-state student enrolled full-time in any program. Scholarships awarded based on merit and financial need.

McNeill-Woodward Endowed Scholarship Two students who are residents of Hoke County. The recipients must demonstrate financial need. May continue second year if qualified.

Jean and Mary Jane Souweine Scholarship The student must be a first year student in any program. Student should have demonstrated potential for success in high school and financial need. May continue second year if overall 2.5 GPA maintained.

Central Electric Scholarship The student must be a first year student in any program. Must be a member of CEMC or child of a member and reside in member home. The selection is based on academics and community activity, and may continue second year.

William Halley Smith and Edith Thomas Scholarship First year students enrolled in any program. The student must be a graduate in the upper 20% of a Moore County school (public or private) and must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Sandhills Community College Scholars Eligible Students graduating in the top 15% of high schools including Pinecrest, Union Pines, North Moore and Hoke High or another area high school. Must maintain a 3.5 GPA.

Travis Hill Memorial Scholarship First year graduate of North Moore High School. The student should maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Fritz and Olga Fuerst Scholarship A first or second year full time deserving student with financial need.

Gwendolyn E. Zimmerman Scholarship Awarded to **(two)** first or second year student selected based on need and merit. Student must maintain 2.0 GPA. First year student may continue receiving scholarship for second year if qualified.

Robert and Temperence Zimmerman Scholarship The recipient may be a first or second year student selection based on need and merit. Student must maintain 2.0 GPA. May continue second year if qualified.

Cato-J. T. Cotner Endowed Scholarship Must be resident where Cato has a market presence. Student must demonstrate financial need. Preference is given to students with evidence of work and community service history.

Luke Marion Scholarship The recipient should be a first year student who is a graduate of Union Pines High School. The student demonstrates potential for success. Financial need should be a consideration. Recommendation and selection provided by Counselors at Union Pines High School.

The Rainmakers Scholarship This scholarship is awarded to a second year student enrolled in any program. The recipient must be a *single parent* who has overcome barriers.

Dr. James E. Cook Endowed Scholarship Any first year student enrolled in any program. The recipient must maintain a 2.0 GPA and demonstrate a potential for success. The student has demonstrated leadership qualities in high school.

Hoke High Class of 1954 Scholarship First or second year student enrolled full-time who is a resident of Hoke County. Student must have financial need.

Dr. Julian Lake and Family Scholarship Any first year student enrolled in any program. The student must maintain a 2.0 GPA. Recommendations should express student's potential for success.

The David & Carolyn Murphy Scholarship The recipient of this scholarship will be a second year student enrolled in any SCC curriculum program who maintains a 3.0 GPA. Selection is based on merit and financial need. Residents of Moore and Montgomery Counties are preferred.

Brownson Presbyterian Church Scholarship Fund The recipient of this scholarship may be a first or second year student who is a current member of Brownson Memorial Presbyterian Church of Southern Pines. A member for at least 2 yrs and must have and maintain a "C" average on high school and college.

General A.G.
