Our three primary annual giving programs/initiatives—all are solicited through mailing in the fall semester:

1. The Annual Fund for Sandhills

• Gifts usually less than \$1,000; unrestricted gifts, often support things such as faculty teaching, professional development, facilities improvement, and the purchase of instructional equipment for classrooms and laboratories.

2. The SCC Guarantors Program

• Gifts of \$1,000 or more designated for the Guarantors Program; flexible financial aid program that provides critical funds for a host of needs that can derail a student's education.

3. The President's 1963 Circle

 Gifts of at least \$1963 = \$1,000 to Guarantors + \$963 to Annual Fund; The President's 1963 Circle celebrate the year of the college's founding - these gifts support two of the core values of Sandhills Community College—Excellence in the programs Sandhills provides AND Opportunity for all students, regardless of their ability of pay for a college education.

Created individually—frequently endowed, but if not, then they are billed annually in early spring:

- The Scholarship Program (for students, financial aid)
- The Awards Program (for students, to recognize Excellence)
- The MiniGrants Program (applied for by faculty and staff to enhance teaching and learning by students)

Other giving programs/initiatives:

- The SCCF Coca-Cola Classic Golf Tournament (our one Fundraising event)
- Flyers Athletics
- Bradshaw Performing Arts Center
- The Sandhills Horticultural Gardens
- Other Designated Gifts (Specific Programs/Departments such as Culinary, Nursing, Automotive, etc., Employee Professional Development)
