PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE NOTES

Radiography is considered a primary credential by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists. The national examination for Radiography Technologits (RT) is recognized by all 50 states.

In some states, earning the RT certification means you're qualified to perform radiographic scans. Other states also require you to have a license, which may involve providing your credentials or taking additional exams. Check with your state board to ensure you meet all the requirements to work as a technologist.

In states where the profession is not regulated at the state level, employers may require education and national credentials.

Some states require that a particular body accredit the educational program. Examples of requirements (among others) may include submission of an official high school or college transcript, a Social Security number, a photo ID, driver's license, or passport. Some states require criminal background checks and fingerprinting. Final determination of individual state requirements for licensure or registry can only be confirmed by that state's governing body.
