Sandhills Community College shall obtain and maintain accreditation through a state-recognized accreditation agency. The College is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) to award associate degrees, diplomas, and certificates.

The accreditation status of the institution shall be posted on the College website in accordance with SACSCOC requirements and included in both the print and electronic versions of the College catalog. Any changes in status will be reported to outside agencies as required by SACSCOC.

To help maintain compliance with accreditation requirements, the College appoints a SACSCOC Liaison. The Liaison is responsible for staying informed of accreditation changes and directives, reporting substantive changes, submitting annual reports required by the Commission, completing the Fifth-Year Report, and coordinating the decennial reaffirmation process.
