Key definitions:

- (1) The ASCP pass rate is defined as the number of graduates who completed and passed the Board of Certification exam (BOC) exam on their first attempt within the first year of graduation.
- (2) The Attrition rate is defined as the number of students who entered the third semester of the MLT program and subsequently completed the program within the next two semesters.
- (3) The graduation rate is defined as the number of graduates who found employment (in the clinical laboratory field or in a closely related field) and/or continued their education within one year of graduation.
