Once we resume normal business hours you can come to campus to have your ID made and pick up your parking sticker.</p> <p>Student ID: Required for all SCC students but will not be available until the college is open. A government issued ID: (i.e. driver’s license), a receipt of tuition paid in full, financial aid award letter, or schedule showing a zero balance will be required.</p> <p>Parking Permit: Register your vehicle online by going to the SCC homepage, click on the MySCC link, then the Parking Sticker link.</p> <p>Currently enrolled students will need to obtain a new sticker for the Fall 2020 semester only.</p>	<p>**Due to COVID-19, Bookstore hours are currently not available.</p> <p>You can order your books online at sandhills.bncollege.com</p>

HYBRID or INTERNET COURSES: For HYBRID courses, students should check Moodle for communication from their instructors on the first day of the class. For INTERNET courses, all Internet courses include an orientation activity to verify your attendance in the course. You must login to your course and complete the activity within the **first three days of the semester** to demonstrate you are actively participating in the course. If you do not complete the activity, you will be dropped from the course.
