Received an award notification <p>If you register for Spring 2021 and decide not to attend SCC, you must officially drop your classes.</p> <p>If you do not officially drop your classes, you will be responsible for all charges.</p>	<p>Refunds are processed only for classes officially dropped using the SCC Course Change form.</p> <p>100% Refund: Classes must be dropped by January 8</p> <p>75% Refund: Classes dropped January 11 – 21</p> <p>No Refund: Classes dropped after January 21</p>	<p>Monday-Friday 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM</p> <p>Student ID: Due to COVID-19, student ID's are only required for SCC students taking any classes that meet on campus. If you are strictly an online student for the Spring 2021 semester you are not required to get an ID.
