<p>If you are using financial aid to pay your tuition, your awarded funds will be applied to your charges only when your Financial Aid application process is complete. Received an award notification <p>If you register for Spring 2022 and decide not to attend SCC, you must officially drop your classes.</p> <p>If you do not officially drop your classes, you will be responsible for all charges.</p>	<p>Refunds are processed only for classes officially dropped using the SCC Course Change form located in student eForms.</p> <p>100% Refund: Traditional 16-week and 1st 8-week sessions : Classes must be dropped by January 7.</p> <p>2nd 8-week classes must be dropped by March 11.</p> <p>75% Refund: Traditional 16-week classes dropped January 10 - 20; 1st 8-week classes dropped January 10 - 13; 2nd 8-week classes dropped March 14 - 17.</p> <p>No Refund: Classes dropped after January 20 for traditional 16-week classes. Classes dropped after January 13 for 1st 8-week classes. Classes dropped after March 17 for 2nd 8-week classes.</p>	<p>Monday-Friday 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM</p> <p>Student ID: Due to COVID-19, student ID's are only required for SCC students taking any classes that meet on campus. If you are strictly an online student for the Spring 2022 semester you are not required to get an ID. HYBRID or INTERNET COURSES: For HYBRID courses, students should check Moodle for communication from their instructors on the first day of the class. For INTERNET courses, all Internet courses include an orientation activity to verify your attendance in the course. You must login to your course and complete the activity within the **first three days of the semester** to demonstrate you are actively participating in the course. If you do not complete the activity, you will be dropped from the course.
