<p>If you are using financial aid to pay your tuition, your awarded funds will be applied to your charges only when your Financial Aid application process is complete. Received an award notification <p>If you register for Fall 2022 and decide not to attend SCC, you must officially drop your classes.</p> <p>If you do not officially drop your classes, you will be responsible for all charges.</p>	<p>Once classes begin, refunds are processed only for classes officially dropped using the SCC Course Change form located in student eForms.</p> <p><u>100% Refund:</u> Traditional 16-week and 1st 8-week sessions : Classes must be dropped by August 12.</p> <p>2nd 8-week classes must be dropped by October 11.</p> <p><u>75% Refund:</u> Traditional 16-week classes dropped August 15 – 24; 1st 8-week classes dropped August 15 – 18; 2nd 8-week classes dropped October 12 – 17.</p> <p><u>No Refund:</u> Classes dropped after August 24 for traditional 16-week classes. Classes dropped after August 18 for 1st 8-week classes. Classes dropped after October 17 for 2nd 8-week classes.</p>	<p>Required for all SCC students for Fall 2022. Issued at the Dempsey Student Center.</p> <p>Student ID: To obtain a student ID you must show a government issued ID (i.e. driver’s license).</p> <p>Parking Stickers: Students must submit a <u>Parking Sticker Registration</u> form through student eForms. Once the form is submitted, the sticker can be picked up at the Switchboard or Upchurch Hall at the Hoke Center.
